- 8. **Keep Thy Space Clean** Clean up after yourself. Leave the classroom as you found it or better. Don't touch other people things.
- Thou Shalt Not Speak Out of Turn Raise your hand and wait to be called on before speaking. This helps keep order and ensures everyone gets a chance to speak.
- 10. Respect and Follow Church Rules While in the church or the classroom, follow the specific conduct expected, such as proper attire, silence during prayer, and participation in rituals or services.
